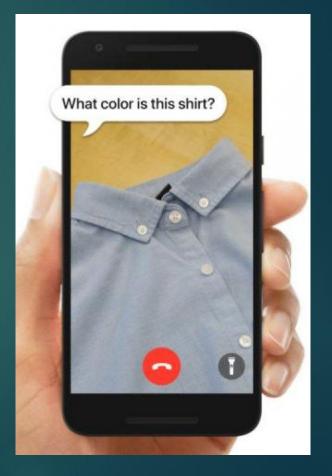
Be My Eyes - Helping the blind

Be My Eyes is all about contributing and benefiting from small acts of kindness, so hop on board and get involved!
